Properties

SunWeave Fibre weave is made of high density polyethylene (HDPE). It is ideal for outdoor use in any climate as it is UV resistant, weatherproof and temperature resistant. The fibre is flexible, and when woven, provides optimal comfort and a structure that is strong and durable yet maintenance-free and easy to clean. The fibre is resistant to chlorine, salt water, tanning lotions and oils.

SunWeave Fibre is also non-toxic and environmentally friendly and fully recyclable.



Cleaning



With a little care, you can keep your SunWeave Woven furniture looking like new for many years.

For routine, general cleaning, simply use warm soapy water and a soft brush to clean off dust and build up. Rinse thoroughly in cold water and polish with a dry cloth.

For tougher stains and more thorough cleaning, we recommend using 303 Multi-Surface Cleaner, following the instructions detailed on the label.

It is important to use a non-foaming cleaner on woven furniture, as a foaming product will leave residues in the gaps in-between the weave which will then attract dirt. A pressure hose on a low setting is suitable to use on woven furniture.



Repairing

Scratch marks or abrasion to the edges of the fibre can be repaired by very briefly and carefully applying heat (i.e. the flame of a cigarette lighter) to the affected area and rubbing along the length of the fibre with a piece of hard cardboard to smooth the edge. This can take some time to perfect, so we suggest you try a couple of test runs on an area of fibre that is hidden from view – i.e. on the underside of the furniture.
